

Digital accessibility declaration

Accessibility status

There is currently no legal requirement in the UK to conduct a formal accessibility audit. However, in line with our commitment to inclusivity and best practice, we are undertaking a formal review of the Website's accessibility against the WCAG 2.2 guidelines.

This review will help identify opportunities to improve accessibility and prioritise changes that support better digital experiences for all users, including those relying on assistive technologies.

A focused review of shared software platforms is planned for summer 2025 to improve accessibility across key Website features. Once complete, this statement will be updated, and a multi-year improvement roadmap will be published.

In parallel, a group-wide digital accessibility master plan is being developed to support a consistent approach across all online platforms operated within our wider European group.
